Chair, Kate Sinicropi, called the monthly meeting of the Town of Romulus Planning Board to order at 7:15 P.M. with roll call followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

March 1, 2010, meeting minutes were read for additions or corrections. Mickie Sanders-Jauquet seconded by Sue Ellen Balluff to accept minutes as read. Motion carried.

April 5, 2010, meeting minutes were read for additions or corrections. Sue Ellen Balluff seconded by Mickie Sanders-Jauquet made motion to accept minutes as read. Motion carried.

New Business: Steve Van Horn and Ryan Van Horn addressed the planning board about getting proper permit to host the (Early Fall Family Jam) music festival, September 24<sup>th</sup> through 26<sup>th</sup> at Cindy and Buster Brown's Kendia Campground on Rt 96A, one mile north of Sampson State Park. Folk, country, rock, acoustic type music. 3 day camping \$50.00, 500-600 people on 46 acres.

New Business: Farmland protection grant for \$25,000 to Town of Romulus has been approved Chair Kate Sinicropi and Tom Bouchard met with Junius town board, and has a copy of their Farmland Protection Plan. Mickie Sanders-Jauquet and Bill Karlsen to work on the request for proposals for soliciting consultants. Stated a community advisory committee would be helpful. Made up of 8-10 farmers and agricultural business people from the town. Tom Bouchard said he would help with interview guide.

Mentioned that the town board did appoint Averell Bauder to our planning board.

Old Business: Vice Chair, Tom Bouchard, reported on lakeshore clean-up day. 10 people helped cut trees and brush and remove trash. Leftover limbs have been chipped up for mulch on site by Seneca County Highway Dept.

Docks and Moorings: Sue Ellen Balluff reported the 5 towns have to re-commit, as it has been two years since process started. Town of Romulus received notice the contract from State Division of Coastal Resources to be sent out within two weeks.

Leash Law Discussion: Sue Ellen Balluff spoke with Harriet Haynes of Seneca County Planning Board. She asked why a leash law just in residential areas. Radio collar controls and invisible fences discussed. Decided to table leash law for now and address in a town survey sometime in the future.

Comprehensive Plan information to be worked on.

Dog Kennel ordinance completed.

Outdoor wood stoves discussed.

Chair, Kate Sinicropi, spoke of her letter to Board of Supervisors about gas well hydro fracking issues.
