There has been o input from the Ambulance Corp. on their financial status and it was felt that a Board Member should be present at their meetings. Supervisor Zajac will check in this.

Supervisor Zajac said that a Dumpster will available twice a year for the residents. The next one will be in the fall of this year.

Election Sites were discussed as it had been suggested that a centralized place be available instead of three Districts. Supervisor Zajac said he would have the laws available by next Board meeting.
