She said more uniform requirements among municipalities would be helpful. Septic systems should be cleaned every 3-5 years. A system should last 25 years. There are grants available if a resident does not have the funds to properly maintain a system. There will be a workshop for Code Inspectors in the future and a notice will be sent out.
