Mary Catt is a member of the Rachael's Challenger Committee with 2 students in the Romulus School District. We started this project over the summer. Right now we are trying to get the word out as our kickoff is next Thursday, September 27, 2007. I will turn this program over to Christopher Catt who is a member of the Romulus School District Peer Mediation Group. Rachael's Challenge was started by the parents of the first girl killed in the Colombine School Happening. It is a nationwide effort to prevent bullying and violence and lower the occurrences in the school systems. We are trying to get the community involved and better inform people about the issues that bullying and violence present. On September 27, 2007, we will be having a Rachel's Challenge kickoff, first for the students with an hour long seminar and what it means to them. After that there will be a community supper in which we invite everyone in the community to join us. The supper is free. At 6:30 pm, after the supper concludes, we will be having a seminar on Rachael's Challenges Goals and what we want to achieve with it. We are also having a community volunteer day, on October 13, 2007.
