Chair, Kate Sinicropi, called the monthly meeting of the Town of Romulus Planning Board to order at 7:05 P.M. with roll call followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

May 3, 2010, meeting minutes were revised. Mickie Sanders-Jauquet made motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Tom Bouchard.

Averell Bauder's resignation was turned in and accepted due to conflict of interest with his new job.

A question about a permit from the town was submitted from Anne Snedacker about, starting an on-line business. Chair Kate Sinicropi is to speak with Supervisor David Kaiser and reply back to her.

The planning board received a copy of a letter to NYS DEC Commissioner, Peter Grannis, from Seneca Lake Pure Waters Association member, Jim Bromka. The letter expresses the group's concern for local watershed in future natural gas drilling processes, and asks for same discretions as Syracuse and New York City watersheds have received.

It was mentioned that the Sampson Veterans Cemetery lost some \$800,000 dollars in state monies, but still going forward.

Jim Williamson, Romulus Highway Superintendent, asked the town board if the planning board could draft an ordinance to require Amish to use rubber tires on liquid manure wagons used that are doing damage to town roads. There is to be an upcoming meeting with Supervisor David Kaiser, Chair Kate Sinicropi, the town's attorney, and Harriet Haynes from county planning in attendance.

Kendai Campground owner, Cindy Brown, was present and answered board member's questions about the Sept. 24-26th music festival proposed. Topics like traffic, security, porta potties; food vendors and health inspections were covered. She also state a registered nurse will head the first aid station. Chair Kate Sinicropi requested a copy of liability insurance policy, if permit is granted. It was also suggested that Cindy Brown contact Fire Chief, Bill Palmer, to notify the dept. of the event, to resolve any concerns or requirements they might have.

Mickie Sanders Jauquet gave a presentation on the Farmland Protection Plan (Request for Proposal) R.F.P. Junius and Lodi's plans were considered in this draft. Our R.F.P. is now to go to county planning for input and direction. Tom Bouchard working on draft interview questions for the committee.

Outdoor wood burning furnace ordinance status is unclear. Article from Finger Lakes Times was read for information.
