Town Attorney, Steve Getman, was present and communicated his direction on the proposed docks & moorings law for the Town of Romulus.

Town of Romulus Right to Farm Law proposal is on county board of supervisors agenda on August 9th. If approved, could be in front of Romulus town board at the August 15th meeting.

Hydrofracking moratorium draft discussed with concerned citizen Larry Yehle taking part.

Alternate member position discussed followed by Sue Ellen Balluff making a motion creating an alternate member position to Town of Romulus Planning Board. Motion seconded by Tom Bouchard. Roll call vote followed with all members voting in favor of alternate membership creation. Motion carried.

Lakeshore vision project status brought up for discussion. The current lakeshore vision grant time frame missed, but lakeshore advisory committee might reconvene after a lease of lakeshore property is established by the town.
