That would be taken up with him. If he reached \$30,000.00 before the end of the year he could retire at any time. We could add a referendum on the regular election ballot and it would not cost us anything. If we ran it separately, it would cost us some money. If whoever takes the job, has to be told that the position could possibly turn out to be an appointed position. Councilman Collinsworth asked to get more information on the cost of the referendum.
