TOPIC FOCUS: *Transportation and Infrastructure*

ACTIONS:

- Identified the Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats pertaining to transportation and infrastructure. **STRENGTHS:** Four (4) North/South state roads; County bus service; cable access available; between two (2) of the largest Finger Lakes; local airport; churches; fire department and hall; public school. **WEAKNESSES:** Lack of power on the Depot; lack of East/West roads; limited broadband; lack of natural gas supply; water and sewer issues; condition of County Road 132 **OPPORTUNITIES:** Open up County Road 135; expand broadband; upgrade County Road 132; increase lake access; increase tourism; increase recreational activities. **THREATS:** Cost; population decline; speed limits; lack of signage onto main roads; government resistance; lack of support from Seneca County.
