- 1) The individuals appointed to the positions of Deputy Town Clerk and Deputy Registrar need not be residents of the Town of Romulus, but must be residents of the County of Seneca.
- 2) Residency shall mean for the purpose of this local law, the actual domicile of an individual.
- 3) This local law shall take effect upon its filing with the office of the Secretary of State.
- 4) This local law as it applies to the position of Deputy Town Clerk and Deputy Registrar shall supersede the requirements of Section 23 of the Town law as said law applies to the Town of Romulus.




