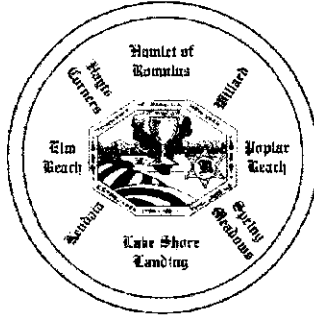

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Town of Romulus Local Law No. 1-2007 Resolution #14-07

A Local Law regulating the parking of vehicles on the Town of Romulus roads and streets.

Be it enacted by the Romulus Town Board of the Town of Romulus, New York as follows:

Section 1: For the purposes of this local law the words “vehicle”, “owner” And “parked” shall have the meanings as defined in the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.

Section 2: No vehicle shall be parked or abandoned on any street or road within the Town of Romulus between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m., during the period beginning November 1st and ending April 1st of each year.

Section 3: When any vehicle is parked or abandoned in violation of this Local Law said vehicle would be subjected to the three-step program, which is as follows:

- a. First day of offense will be issued a warning ticket
- b. Second offense will be issued a ticket
- c. Third day will be towed at owner’s expense and not to be released until all fees have been paid.

Section 4: After such removal the said police officer or public official may store such vehicle in a suitable place at the expense of the owner. Such owner or person in charge of the vehicle may redeem the same upon payment in the amount of all expenses actually and necessarily incurred in effecting such removal, together with any charges for storage.

Section 5: The said police officer or public official shall ascertain the owner of such vehicle or person having same in charge and to notify owners of the removal and disposition of such vehicle and of the amount which will be required to redeem the same.

Section 6: The violation of Section 2 of this Local Law as a second offense by any person shall be deemed an offense against this Local Law and shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$50.00.

Section 7: An exception to the time restraints for parking on the streets and roads would be for that of a business who advertises their hours of operation beyond the midnight hour. Therefore, under this circumstance patrons will be allowed to park until 2:30 a.m.

Section 8: An additional exception to this Local Law would be for those residents that do not have adequate parking or no driveway. Under these circumstances the Romulus Town Board would issue a hanging exception tag. This tag must hang from said vehicles interior windshield mirror so as to be easily readable by police officers and public officials. If an exception tag is warranted it will be at the discretion of the Romulus Town Board as to whether or not the request is viable enough to receive an exception tag.


Section 9: This Local law shall supersede in so far as it contradicts, any other ordinance, order, rule or regulation previously adopted by the Romulus Town Board.

Section 10: A copy of this Local Law will be filed with the State of New York and also will be provided to all local police enforcement agencies.
