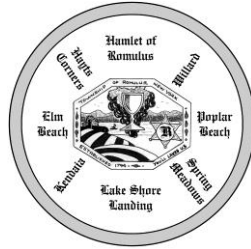

TOWN BOARD MINUTES FOR APRIL 19, 2021

Meeting called to order at 6pm by Town Supervisor. All were present. Pledge to our flag and a moment of silence.

Petitioner to Board: Mr. George Gedon from East Lake Rd Romulus had several concerns about activities above their property—mainly water mitigation. He spoke with Supervisor Hayes and Highway Supervisor Daryl Morrell. Several questions were his primary concerns: a. Is an engineer involved? Daryl is following Matt Everdyke's directions, Gabion rock added, has a minimum 25-year lifespan and slows water flow. Also, addition rock to be added (both gabion and large stone at the outlet). There is also check dams to be installed. All will further slow water. There is also a ditch that is 150 feet between pipe outlet and outlet under road that are all design to slow the water as well. The main reason for all of this was because Jeff Bond's property was initially very wet, and there was a need to change flow of water and cleaning out the ditch. The initial solution was to connect a 10 "pipe under the road and also connect a 4" pipe. All of this was also discussed with several long-term residents and Ann Jardine—Lakeshore resident, chairing storm water management committee and there does not seem to be a significant water issue at this point in time. The Town will complete its obligations. The HOA will discuss internal actions.

Petitioner to Board: Mark Benjamin- Seneca Meadows will have an Open House on July 25 at Noon to 4 pm. Also, May 8th is Mulch day- 2 free scoops of mulch will be loaded into your containers. This is a free until there is no more.
