TOWN OF ROMULUS TOWN BOARD MEETING

September 21, 2022

1. Call to order by Supervisor David Hayes at 1800 on September 21, 2022
2. Roll call was taken. All members are present and accounted for,
3. The Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence for all
4. There was no Petitioners to the Board however Steve Bromka was present, to bring updates to the Board and Attorney for the Lake Shore Landing Road maintenance agreement
5. A motion to approve the Previous Meeting Minutes, August 17th 2022 was made by Councilman Michael Joslyn and Seconded by Councilman Joseph Brodnicki. Motion carried
6. There was our monthly communications from **Charter**. It was read and acknowledge.
7. There were reports from the **Highway supervisor**. All is going as normal for this time of year. The Highway Department had to fix truck #2 springs. The truck is repaired and back on the road.
8. **Zoning Officer/Code Enforcement Officer** did have a report this month. In the report it was noted that he sent notice of violations to Earl Martin for having drag races and food vendors on the former Depot air strip. Stated that he feels both will require Special Use Permits.
9. **The Water and Sewer Reports** were also gone over and all seems to be happening right on schedule. Everyone read and accepted the report. The water capacity has to be lowered and will happen soon. This should help with the slightly higher levels of THM's (by-products)
10. **Supervisor David Hayes** asked Bookkeeper to give the financial report this month. The Book Keeper Angela Teste submitted the report on behalf of the Town Supervisor Dave Hayes. Everyone was reminded about the budget request and the workshops coming up. Supervisor Hayes also stated that Councilman Mike Joslyn and he are still waiting for the State to hold up their end of the deal about our water situation. He will keep everyone informed as things happen
11. A motion to approve the **Town Clerks Reports** by Councilman Michael Joslyn and seconded by Councilman Joseph Brodnicki. Motion approved
12. There was no **Zoning Board of Appeals** report at this time
13. Planning Board members stated that they had a few questions about Mr. Martin still having the Drag races even if they were not in compliance. This was already scheduled to be discussed in Old business.
14. **Old Business** Regarding #13 questions about compliance of violations that Mr. Martin was issued by Zoning Enforcement Officer, Tim Dorn; The Town Clerks office sent by certified & regular mail to Mr. Martin the violations notices. Attorney Patrick Morrell stated that he can still have the scheduled events even if not in compliance. He really doubted that the police would go and stop this event. It is the

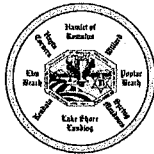
