

# TOWN C MULUS

Minutes, Town Board – Wednesday, October 19, 2022, at 6:00PM

Supervisor David Hayes call the Romulus Town Board to order at 1805. He asks for roll call to be taken. All Board members were present

8. Planning Board report was given by Tom Bouchard. All the items that they are working on are proceeding along on time. They are writing a \$5000 grant request from Myaccount+++++++the county .
9. Supervisor Hayes had nothing to report at this time other than making all the walk arounds on Willard State Hospital. He also brought up the fact that we have a letter of resignation from a Planning Board member.
10. Town Clerk reports were read, and a motion was made by Councilman Michael Joslyn and seconded by Councilwoman Melody Collinworth. Motion carried.
