Resolution 23-036 – State Environmental Quality Review Act Type II Regarding Town of Romulus Infiltration & Inflow Improvements

WHEREAS the Town of Romulus (hereinafter the “Town”) proposes to reduce infiltration and inflow (I&I) intrusion into the municipal sanitary sewer system by repairing, replacing, and/or rehabilitating preexisting manholes and sewer pipelines; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”), the Town is required to assess impacts to the environment in compliance with SEQRA regulations included in 6 NYCRR Part 617 (Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations); and

WHEREAS the Town of Romulus is the appropriate agency to be the lead agency to undertake the project review under SEQRA; and

WHEREAS 6 NYCRR §617.5 under SEQRA provides that certain actions identified in subdivision (c) of that section are Type II actions and not subject to environmental review under SEQRA and that such activities include “maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing structure or facility” (§617.5(c)(1)), “replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site” (§617.5(c)(2)), and “street openings and right-of-way openings for the purpose of repair or maintenance of existing utility facilities” (§617.5(c)(6)); and

WHEREAS the proposed improvements consist solely of repairing, replacing, and/or rehabilitating preexisting manholes and sewer pipelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that based on such review and consideration, the Town of Romulus Town Board is the lead agency for the SEQRA review of the proposed project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the proposed project is a Type II action which is not subject to review under SEQRA, and it will not result in a significant adverse impact on the environment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Town Supervisor is hereby authorized to sign and file, or have filed, on behalf of the Town of Romulus all documents necessary to comply with SEQRA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
